Questions You May Have...

Q. How far do I have to walk?

A. There are 3 courses ranging from 1 to 4 miles, so all ages can participate and strollers are welcome!

Q. How much can I raise?

A. There is no limit - you'll be surprised how easy it is.

Q. What if I can't be there on Walk Day?

A. No Worries! You can walk on your own at a time that's convenient for you. Just register online then make arrangements to get your sponsorships to our staff.

Q. What if it rains?

A. Bring an umbrella and walk. Or, walk another time on your own and make arrangements to get your sponsorships to our staff.

Q. How do I raise sponsorships?

A. Just tell everyone you know and ask them to sponsor you. Most people will support you! Send your out of town friends and family an email with a link to give online or a mailer and they can return their contribution directly to the Lois' Lodge office.
